The BioHorizon team is happy to announce the launching of this years' benchmarking exercise. All Bio-NCPs will be invited to take part in the exercise, which is set to commence on the **20th of March**. Make sure you participate and take the opportunity to win a BioHorizon pen drive, through **the prize draw** that will follow.

The exercise consists of **two questionnaires**, one for all NCPs and one with specific questions for Bio-NCPs. The exercise is very important, as it will give the opportunity to each Bio-NCP to compare their performance and practices with other Bio-NCPs and NCPs from other thematic areas and other countries.

It will also give the BioHorizon project an overview of the NCPs needs, strengths and weaknesses and will provide valuable input on the future training plans. It is necessary to have high participation in order to get reliable results and useful conclusions for the next period.

The questionnaires are small and **no more than 10 minutes** of your time will be required to complete them. So make sure you participate! The questionnaires will be available for completion on the online tool, **from the 3**rd **of April until the 1**st **of May**, which will be the deadline for submission.

THE BIOHORIZON PRACTICAL GUIDE FOR BIO-NCPS

The BioHorizon practical guide for Bio-NCPs is a comprehensive collection of information and practical guidelines on how to perform the daily work of a Bio-NCP.
